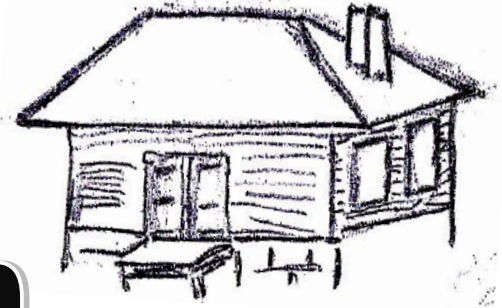
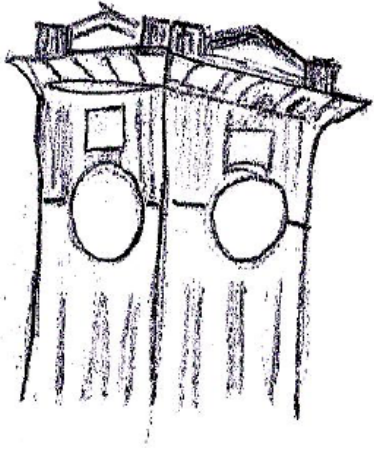


Brownstown Ewing ARTSFEST
